Joint Motion to Amend Scheduling Order

The parties, by and through their respective counsel, hereby move to amend the Court's scheduling order, *see Caster* ECF No. 275. As the Court is aware, counsel for the *Milligan* Plaintiffs also represent plaintiffs in *Stone v. Allen*, Case No. 21-cv-1531, in which trial is currently ongoing and scheduled to be completed by November 22, 2024. The amended deadlines allow *Milligan* Plaintiffs and the State to focus on the ongoing trial in that case and have adequate time to prepare their respective witness and exhibit lists in advance of trial in this case. The amended deadlines do not prejudice either the *Caster* or *Singleton* Plaintiffs, both of whom consent to the proposed amended schedule. Moreover, Plaintiffs propose moving the deadline for deposition designations and adding in other deadlines to account for counter-designations, exhibit objections, and stipulations, all of which will assist the Court in making pretrial determinations and streamline trial.

As such, the parties respectfully request the following amendment to scheduling order:

The parties shall file any replies in support of motions in limine, <i>Daubert</i> motions, and counter-designations of deposition testimony for trial	January 10, 2025	January 15, 2025
The parties shall file stipulated facts for trial		January 15, 2025
The Court will by separate order set a final pretrial conference to occur	Within 30 days of February 3, 2025	Within 30 days of February 10, 2025
Trial	February 10, 2025	February 10, 2025

Granting the parties' request will result in modest modifications to the current schedule while ensuring that the trial date remains the same. Additionally, as the current deadlines were set according to the original trial date of February 3, 2025, and not the amended trial date of February 10, the amended schedule should still provide the Court adequate time to review the parties' pretrial motions prior to the final pretrial conference. Accordingly, for good cause shown, the parties respectfully

request that the Court amend the scheduling order to the deadlines proposed herein and in the attached proposed order.

3. The parties shall file any opposition to motions in limine and *Daubert* motions, and designations of deposition testimony for trial on or before **January 8, 2025**.
4. The parties shall file any replies in support of motions in limine and *Daubert* motions, and counter-designations of deposition testimony for trial on or before **January 15, 2025**.
5. The parties shall also file stipulated facts for trial on or before **January 15, 2025**.
6. The Court will by separate order set a final pretrial conference to occur within 30 days of **February 10, 2025**.
