STATE DEFENDANTS' JOINT NOTICE CONCERNING FEC EXHIBITS

Secretary of State Allen, Senator Livingston, and Representative Pringle (the State Defendants) jointly notify the Court concerning DX266 through DX272, DX275 through DX284, and DX287 through DX289 as follows:

1. The State Defendants offered DX266 through DX289 into evidence. Daily Trial Tr. 2463:17-19.

2. *Milligan* counsel, speaking for *Milligan* Plaintiffs and *Caster* Plaintiffs, raised objections which resulted in the State Defendants withdrawing DX273, DX274, DX285, and DX286. With respect to the remaining exhibits in this group, the issue was to be revisited the next day. Daily Trial Tr. 2463:20-2471:6. The *Singleton* Plaintiffs took the same position as the *Milligan* and *Caster* Plaintiffs. Daily Trial Tr. 2471:7-8.

3. The next day, *Milligan* counsel expressed a willingness to drop some objections and explained their “remaining potential concern is about completeness of these records[.]” The State Defendants committed to provide additional information and the Court reserved ruling. Daily Trial Tr. 2520:18-2523:7.

4. DX266 through DX272, DX275 through DX284, and DX287 through DX289 are records from the Federal Election Commission’s website at www.fec.gov. Our records indicate that these exhibits were produced in discovery on May 9, 2024, and that they were downloaded on April 15, 2024.

5. With the State Defendants' provision of this information, the *Milligan*, *Caster*, and *Singleton* Plaintiffs have agreed to withdraw their objections and have authorized the undersigned to represent the same to the Court.
