**PLAINTIFFS' UNOPPOSED JOINT MOTION
TO EXTEND DEADLINE TO SUBMIT
POST-TRIAL FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

Pursuant to Rule 16(b)(4) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Plaintiffs in these three cases respectfully request that the Court grant a short extension of time to file post-trial proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law from the current deadline of Wednesday, March 12, 2025, to Monday, March 17, 2025. Defendants take no position on this motion, but request that if the Court grants Plaintiffs' motion, the Court also extend the deadline for Defendants.

Plaintiffs have good cause for this short extension for two primary reasons. First, given the structure of these three cases, this additional time would better allow for Plaintiffs in the three separate cases to coordinate and reduce the amount of duplicative material submitted to the Court. Second, given the length of trial and existence of previous proceedings in these cases, this extension would help ensure that Plaintiffs are able to provide a fulsome account of the evidence and testimony, whether submitted through preliminary proceedings, deposition designations, or live testimony at the recent trial.

Accordingly, the Plaintiffs in these three cases respectfully request that the Court grant them an extension of the deadline to file for proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law to March 17, 2025.
