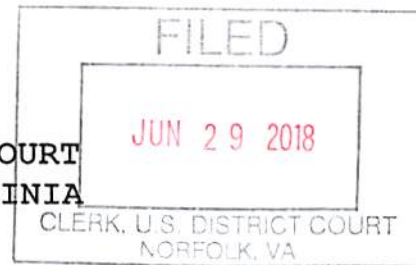

AMENDED AFFIDAVIT OF LATASHA HOLLOWAY

Latasha Holloway, who first being duly sworn, made oath as follows:

1. I am the named Plaintiff in the above stated action.
2. I am an African American citizen of and register voter in the City of Virginia Beach, Virginia, and reside at 3683 Windmill Drive, Virginia Beach, Virginia 23453.
3. I have been active in civil rights and political rights in the City of Virginia Beach over five years. I have been actively involved in the Democratic Party of Virginia Beach for a year; and I have been dedicated to endorsing and supporting political candidates whose election would be in the best interests of the African American citizens of the City.
4. Based upon my political experience and involvement in campaigns, I believe there are rules and procedures that prevent or discourage African American citizens in the City of Virginia Beach from registering to vote, voting, or

otherwise participating fully in the political process. I further believe that African American voters in Virginia Beach under the at-large election system in combination with racially polarized voting, prevent African American voters from electing their candidates of choice where they are not the majority in the jurisdiction. Under this system, the votes of African American voters are drowned out or submerged by the votes of the majority of white voters who often do not support the candidates preferred by African American voters.

5. I think there is no good reason to expect that one or more of the African American candidates currently running for the City Council seats will be elected if the November 6, 2018 election is not postponed.

6. I am in favor of enjoining at-large elections in Virginia Beach and believe that this system adversely affects the opportunity of African American citizens to participate in the political process and prevents them from electing candidates of their choice.


7. I am in favor of single-member districts or wards for the election of all eleven members of the Virginia Beach City Council which provides the African American voters of Virginia Beach with a remedy for the above-stated violations of their rights.

8. Postponement of the November 6, 2018 election would not be particularly harmful to the aspirations of African American candidates because of the persistent vote dilution in the councilmanic election.
