**MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT WITH
RESPECT TO NEWTON PLAINTIFFS' CLAIMS**

Pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 56, the State of Alabama,
Robert J. Bentley, in his official capacity as Governor of Alabama, and Beth
Chapman, in her official capacity as Secretary of State of Alabama, defendants in

this action (the “Newton State Defendants”), move for entry of summary judgment in their favor and against the Newton Plaintiffs on their claims that the 2012 Alabama legislative redistricting plans violate Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act, are the product of unconstitutional racial gerrymandering, and otherwise violate the Fourteenth Amendment to the U.S. Constitution. As grounds for this Motion, the Newton State Defendants state that they are entitled to judgment as a matter of law and there are no genuine issues of material fact.

Additional grounds for this Motion are set forth in the Memorandum in Support of Motion for Summary Judgment, its exhibits, and the affidavits and other exhibits already of record in this case.
