**DEFENDANTS’ RESPONSE TO THE COURT’S MAY 5, 2017 ORDER**

In response to the Court’s May 5, 2017 Order (ECF No. 154), and consistent with their role in this litigation,<sup>1</sup> Defendants, the Virginia State Board of Elections, *et al.*, express no position regarding which factual findings and legal conclusions in the Court’s memorandum opinion (ECF No. 108) remain in effect on remand, and therefore are not filing a brief in support of any position.
