**ORDERED** that:

1. An Evidentiary and Preliminary Injunction Hearing on the Expedited Motion for Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 26) is now set before the undersigned United States Magistrate Judge for **Wednesday, March 29, 2023, at 9:30 A.M.** in the Miami Division of this Court, at the C. Clyde Atkins United States Courthouse, 11th Floor, 301 North Miami Avenue, Miami, Florida 33128.


2. By no later than **12:00 noon on Wednesday, March 22, 2023**, each side shall file a Notice identifying the amount of time it anticipates it will need to present its case at the Evidentiary and Preliminary Injunction Hearing.

3. By no later than **Friday, March 24, 2023**, any Party who intends to present live

testimony must file a witness list identifying the witness(es) that the Party intends to call at the Evidentiary and Preliminary Injunction Hearing.

4. All exhibits shall be pre-marked for the hearing and served (**not filed**) on opposing counsel by no later than **Friday, March 24, 2023**. The Parties shall confer prior to the Evidentiary and Preliminary Injunction Hearing regarding their exhibits to identify which exhibits they will stipulate to entry into evidence at the hearing and to narrow their anticipated objections.
