**JOINT MOTION TO AMEND STIPULATION AND ORDER REGARDING
DISCOVERY**

Plaintiffs Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc., Sixth District of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Eric T. Woods, Katie Bailey Glenn, Phil Brown, and Janice Stewart, and Defendant Brad Raffensperger, in his official capacity as the Georgia Secretary of State, entered into a stipulation and order regarding the schedule for discovery in this case on October 6, 2022, which the court approved on October 7, 2022. *See* Dkt. 164. The parties subsequently sought and the Court ordered brief extensions of certain deadlines concerning fact and third-party discovery. *See* Dkts. 179, 184. Expert discovery is currently set to close on February 17, 2023. *See* Dkt. 133.

The parties have worked diligently to set expert depositions on the previously entered schedule, but require a short extension of time to accommodate the schedule of Defendant’s expert Dr. John Alford. Dr. Alford is being deposed on February 27, 2023.

To that end, the parties jointly move this Court to amend the prior stipulation and order to permit Dr. Alford’s deposition on February 27, 2023.
