ORDER

This matter appears before the Court on Plaintiffs' Motion to Strike (Doc. No. [243] ¹). Doc. No. [247]. Plaintiffs inadvertently filed their Response to Defendant's Statement of Facts at (Doc. No. [243]) and subsequently filed the Response to Defendant's Statement of Facts at (Doc. No. [245]). Additionally, (Doc. No. [243]) is mislabeled as a Response in Opposition to Defendant's Motion



for Summary Judgment. Because motions to strike only apply to pleadings, Fed. R. Civ. P. 12(b), the Court **DENIES** the Motion to Strike (Doc. No. [247]).

However, the Court, in an effort to perfect the Docket, **DIRECTS** the Clerk that access to (Doc. No. [243]) shall be restricted to Court users. The Clerk shall also modify the CM/ECF docket text to show the document as RESTRICTED. The Court further perfects the record to state that it will give no consideration to Doc. No. [243] as it prepares to issue a ruling on the pending summary judgment motion. Any reference to Plaintiffs' Response to Defendant's Statement of Material Facts shall be to (Doc. No. [245]).

The Clerk is further **DIRECTED** to modify the description for Doc. No. [246] to Plaintiffs' Statement of Additional Facts.
