

MEMORANDUM ORDER

Plaintiffs filed a timely Motion for Leave to Amend Complaint (Doc. 98). As required by local rule, Plaintiffs contacted defense counsel for their position regarding the proposed amendment. Defense counsel stated that they opposed the motion and objected to certain revisions, including references to a Joiner Supplemental Report. Plaintiffs stated in their motion that they have removed all references to that report in their proposed Second Amended Complaint.

The motion was noticed for briefing, the fourteen-day period for filing opposition passed, and no defendant has filed any opposition to the motion. Considering the liberal policy in favor of allowing amendments, the timeliness of the proposed amendment, and the lack of opposition, the **Motion for Leave to Amend Complaint (Doc. 98)** is **granted**.
