**DISMISSAL ORDER**

On May 9, 2022, the Court entered an Order dismissing the above-captioned civil matter without prejudice, to allow the Plaintiffs to bring a challenge to the County’s remedial redistricting map after the July 19, 2022, election. ECF No. 85. The Plaintiffs did not bring such a challenge.

On June 6, 2022, the Plaintiffs filed a motion for attorneys’ fees and litigation expenses. ECF No. 86. On July 6, 2022, the Court issued an Order staying the briefing of the Plaintiff’s motion, pending *en banc* review of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit’s decision in *Stinnie v. Holcomb*, No. 21-1756 (4th Cir. June 27, 2022). *See* ECF No. 89.

On March 7, 2025, the Plaintiffs filed a notice of withdrawal of their motion for attorneys’ fees and litigation expenses (ECF No. 86). ECF No. 117.

In light of the foregoing, the Court:

- (1) **DENIES-as-MOOT** the Plaintiff’s motion for attorneys’ fees and litigation expenses (ECF No. 86); and
- (2) **DISMISSES** this matter **WITH PREJUDICE**.

The Clerk is **DIRECTED** to **CLOSE** the case.
