Pending before the Court are the following motions:

- Motion for Protective Order and to Quash Non-Party Deposition Subpoenas Served on Delegate Curtis S. Anderson and Senator C. Anthony Muse (ECF No. 126), and
- Motion for Protective Order to Modify Non-Party Deposition Subpoena Served on Robert Garagiola (ECF No. 127).

Both motions rest upon the invocation of legislative privilege and seek protection from Plaintiffs' requests to discover evidence regarding legislative intent with respect to Maryland's 2011 redistricting plan.
