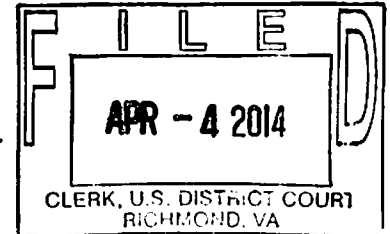

**ORDER**

Having reviewed the MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENAS TO ROBERT B. BELL, WILLIAM ROBERT JANIS, AND CHRISTOPHER MARSTON AND/OR FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER (Docket No. 61) and the MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES IN SUPPORT OF MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENAS TO ROBERT B. BELL, WILLIAM ROBERT JANIS, AND CHRISTOPHER MARSTON AND/OR FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER (Docket No. 62) by which two Virginia legislators ask that they not be deposed in this action and their lawyer asks that he be neither deposed nor required to produce documents, and having reviewed the lawyer's objections to producing the documents called for by the subpoena, and having established a briefing schedule (Docket No. 70), it is hereby ORDERED that:

(1) Oral argument on the Motion to Quash shall be tentatively scheduled for 10 A.M. on April 18, 2014.

(2) Should the Court determine that it is not possible to hear argument on April 18, argument will be heard at 10 A.M. on April 30, 2014.

After the issues have been joined and the appropriate response briefs have been filed, the final date for argument will be determined.

It is so ORDERED.
