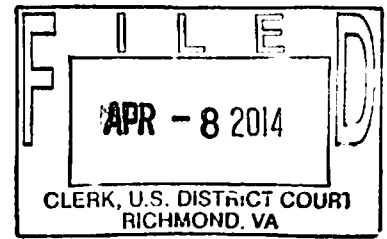

ORDER

Having reviewed third party Christopher Marston's MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME (Docket No. 76), and having convened a conference call with counsel for Marston and the Plaintiff, and having been informed by the parties that any relevant objections will be handled by briefing on the third parties' MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENAS TO ROBERT B. BELL, WILLIAM ROBERT JANIS, AND CHRISTOPHER MARSTON AND/OR FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER (Docket No. 61), rendering a separately filed Motion to Compel Production unnecessary, the Court hereby modifies its previous scheduling order, (Docket No. 70), as follows:
