ORDER GRANTING THE PARTIES' JOINT MOTION TO AMEND
THE SCHEDULING ORDER

This matter comes before the court upon the parties' Joint Motion to Amend the Scheduling Order, or in the Alternative, for Leave to Conduct Deposition Out of Time (the "Motion"). (Doc. 93.)

In their Motion, the parties have moved the court to amend its May 7, 2015 Scheduling Order (Doc. 91) for the sole purpose of extending the deadline for the parties to conduct the deposition of Defendants' expert witness Dr. Thomas B. Hofeller, up to and including Friday, September 11, 2015. The court is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the Motion, and that

the court therefore does not need to reach the alternative request for relief.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the parties Joint Motion (Doc. 93) is **GRANTED** and that the parties may conduct the deposition of Defendants' expert witness Dr. Thomas B. Hofeller no later than September 11, 2015. Nothing in this Order shall be construed as modifying any other provision of the Scheduling Order.
