ORDER OF COURT	

Upon consideration of the “Petition for Judicial Review and Request for This Court to Establish a Schedule Under Colo. Const. Art. V., § 44.5(1)” filed in the above cause,

The supreme court invites the Colorado Independent Legislative Redistricting Commission, the Secretary of State, the Attorney General, and any other interested person to file simultaneous briefs concerning the Petition* with the Clerk of the Colorado Supreme Court not later than noon on July 22, 2021, addressing this court’s authority to modify the constitutional deadlines for submission and review of final redistricting plans, and/or the practical impact of delaying final review of such plans on the conduct of the 2022 elections. The briefs may contain no more than 9,500 words and must comply with C.A.R. 32.
