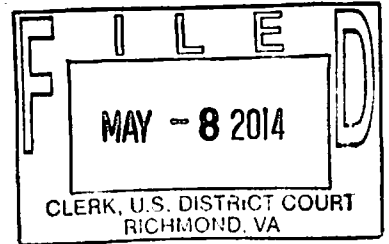

ORDER

For the reasons set forth in the accompanying Memorandum Opinion, the non-party Christopher Marston's MOTION TO QUASH SUBPOENAS TO ROBERT B. BELL, WILLIAM ROBERT JANIS, AND CHRISTOPHER MARSTON AND/OR FOR A PROTECTIVE ORDER, Docket No. 61, is DENIED IN PART with respect to the assertion of a legislative privilege. It is ORDERED that, by 10:00 AM on May 12, 2014, Marston shall deliver to counsel for the Plaintiffs all documents within the scope of the Plaintiff's subpoena (as modified by the Memorandum Opinion) that were not subject to a claim of attorney-client privilege and addressed by this Court's order of May 5, 2014, Docket No. 90, Attachment A.
