1. The North Carolina Supreme Court's most recent opinion day was March 7, 2014, and that Court did not issue an opinion in the *State Redistricting Cases* on that date.
2. The next scheduled date upon which the North Carolina Supreme Court may potentially release opinions or other rulings is April 11, 2014. Any subsequent opinion release dates have not been publicly announced.
